### **2018 St. Patrick Church Cemetery Regulation Overview**

The cemetery is intended for the visitation of grave sites by family and friends. The cemetery grounds and the surrounding land and trails are not intended for public use such as walking, dog walking, or congregating with friends. Signs have been posted on the premises advising visitors that dog walking is not allowed and that trespassing is not allowed in the wooded areas of the cemetery.

#### **Gravesite Regulations**

- Flowers or small plants are permitted within 10 inches around the monument.
- Cut flowers are permitted in appropriate conservative containers or laid directly on the ground.
- Wreaths and Christmas flower decorations are permitted, but must be removed by March 1.
- American flags are permitted on the graves of military veterans.
- Small, conservative items such as angels or other appropriate sentimental objects may be placed in front of memorials.
- The Cemetery Manager reserves the right to remove impermissible objects, overgrown plantings, dead plantings or items deemed inappropriate for the cemetery at any time.
- St. Patrick Church is not responsible for lost, stolen or removed items. We will, however, temporarily store removed non-perishable items for retrieval by family members. Please contact the Cemetery Manager.
